

# **2015 Summer Scholarships Information Sheet**

The Starkville Area Arts Council (SAAC) announces the availability of scholarships for Starkville/Oktibbeha area youth interested in advanced training in the arts during the summer months. The scholarship money may be used to support private instruction in the arts: group lessons, private lessons, tuition for a workshop or summer camp, competition fees, or other activities that lead to the artistic development of the scholarship recipient.

Students requesting the SAAC Arts Scholarship must be between 10 and 18 years old, not yet attending college, and should be accepted to advanced training (lessons, workshops, conferences, competitions, etc.).
